**PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS PRESENT:** Gerald Lehman, Jeff McNeal and Charles Long.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Gerald Lehman called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

The planning commission changed some wording in the mission statement for the Dayton Downtown Initiative to read: *Enhancing the character of Dayton by highlighting and promoting history, interest, commerce and tourism.*

After much discussion a motion by Charles Long was seconded by Jeff McNeal and passed unanimously to recommend to council to hire someone for \$15,600.00 per year with less than 20 hours per week at \$15.00 per hour to coordinate/facilitate the Dayton Downtown Initiative.
