



TOWN OF DAYTON RECYCLING PROGRAM

The Town of Dayton provides curbside collection of recyclables for Town residents and small businesses. Recyclables are collected on Thursdays of each week. Recycling bins are furnished by the Town, and can be obtained by calling the Public Works Department at (540) 879-2241. The following items are acceptable for recycling collection:

- Plastic containers - all recycling codes accepted (discard lids), no plastic bags, plastic wrap or Styrofoam
- Aluminum beverage cans & pie pans
- Glass bottles & jars (clear, green & brown), non-shattering glass only—(no windows, mirrors, picture frame glass, etc.)
- Tin cans
- Paper (shredded paper also accepted) - all paper must be contained in a trash bag and put inside the bin, separate from newspaper
- Newspaper (no need to bag) - no phone books
- Cardboard & paperboard (flatten) - must be no larger than the size of the bin when flattened

HEAVY TRASH COLLECTION

The following items are acceptable for heavy trash collection on the first Tuesday of each month (items are recycled at the landfill):

- Appliances
- Furniture
- Electronics
- Bicycles
- Small lawn mowers (remove gas & oil)
