

# DAYTON TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

September 14, 2015

**COUNCIL MEMEBERS PRESENT:** Mayor Charles Long, Council members; Shelley Newman, Laura Daily, Jeff Daly, Kehris Snead & Josh Lyons.

**COUNCIL MEMEBERS ABSENT:** Steve Dean

**CALL TO ORDER:** Mayor Long called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM and welcomed everyone. The Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance were led by Mayor Long.
