- It was brought into question how much money the Town spends on staff, equipment, supplies etc. for the Muddler. Councilperson Jeff Daly addressed the question; he explained that all Town events are paid for by the vendors and participants in these events, they as a Council make sure these events aren't at the cost of the Town or its residents.
- A suggestion that water bills for Town Residents be reduced for the months of June – August to allow for watering lawns and such. Mayor Long addressed the question; Council will revisit the decision on water rates for July – August.
- A request for parking lines to be added to the Fuzzy Duck lot to better encourage people to park there.
- A resident spoke about receiving a traffic summons from the Police Dept. and the negative way he felt he was treated in the process. Council expressed their apologies to the resident for any bad feelings toward the PD.
- The PD was thanked for being proactive about speeding on Silver Lake Road.
- Clean-Up at the radiator shop seems to be improving.
