Autumn Greetings!

The weather is generally pleasant, people are outside walking and greeting neighbors, leaves are showing their brilliant colors, the sunflower field is blooming, fall decorations are up, and, of course, Dayton Days brings tens of thousands of visitors to Dayton. More importantly, for me, it includes Thanksgiving – a reminder to be grateful in our everyday lives and to show thanks for all that we have.

What are you most thankful for? For me, it's that I get to live and work in a community I love. I am grateful that when my grandchildren come to visit, we can walk or ride our bikes to parks and cultural resources. When friends come to visit, we can walk to locally owned businesses and dine at locally owned restaurants. I appreciate that our little town allows us to know our neighbors and support them as needed. Others in the area have recently shown great appreciation for the local farmer who plants a sunflower field for all in the community to enjoy and for others that make our community so special.

I am also thankful for the amazing staff we have working for the Town of Dayton. In a time of heavy staff turnover in other communities, we have retained excellent staff who are committed to the Town's residents and businesses. Lately, I have received many compliments from people who go out of their way to come into the office or call or email to compliment staff and let me know they appreciate the way staff has handled something.

Work continues on several projects in town:

- A new 45 second promotional video was produced and is already being shown on The Dayton Market visitors' screen, the Town's website, and at Massanutten. We will continue to look for additional places to advertise Dayton. A longer video will be produced after Dayton Days.
- The Water Treatment Plant upgrade is moving along quickly. The building is up, pipes are in, and preparations are being made for tanks and other infrastructure. Equipment will be delivered in October.
- Sidewalks have been replaced on some of College Street and others will be completed soon.
- A public meeting was held for the Downtown Revitalization Planning Grant. Dozens of people came to learn about the project and give input. A JMU intern, Chris Hurt, is working on mapping and inventory.
- The Comprehensive Plan is also moving forward and has gone to the Central Shenandoah Planning District Commission for assistance on the transportation chapter. A final public meeting will be held early next year prior to adoption.

Town Staff, Planning Commission & CSPDC Experience Horse & Buggy Rides First Hand



Town staff, Planning Commission Members, and Regional Transportation Planners with the Central Shenandoah Planning District Commission (CSPDC) recently took a horse and buggy ride to better understand the needs for all modes of transportation. Sharing the road with horse-drawn buggies requires enhanced courtesy, focus and safety awareness. Horses may be unpredictable and are easily spooked by noisy exhaust pipes, horns, squealing brakes and other unexpected sounds. This makes the buggies and their passengers quite vulnerable on public roads. Here are some tips for motorists to follow:

- Slow down and pay attention when you share the road with a horse-drawn buggy.
- Leave plenty of room between your vehicle and the buggy, especially when passing or if the buggy is stopped at an intersection.
- Give yourself plenty of room to return safely to your lane if you're facing oncoming traffic, just as you would when passing a car and slow down when driving over a blind hill or around a sharp turn.
