

Town Hall closes at noon on Wednesday, November 22, and will be closed on Thursday, November 23, and Friday, November 24.

Trash pick-up will be delayed until Saturday, November 25.

Christmas

Town Hall closes at noon on Friday, December 22 and will be closed on Monday, December 25. Trasb pick-up will be delayed until Saturday, December 30.

New Year's

Town Hall will be closed on Monday, January 1 Trasb pick-up will be delayed until Saturday, January 6.

<u>Christmas Tree Pick-up</u>

Real Christmas trees will be picked up the first two weeks of January. Please leave them at the curb (not in the street or blocking the sidewalk) with all tinsel, hooks, and other items removed.

Leaf Vacuuming Service

The Town has started leaf vacuuming service and will continue to go throughout the entire Town until the first week in December. There is no set schedule—leaves will be vacuumed as time and weather permits. Please be patient with staff as they do their best to accommodate all houses. Leaves must be raked to the curb by the edge of the property line; however, please do not put leaves in the street, on the sidewalk, or on top of graveled driveways. Please try to keep leaf piles free of debris as that can clog the machine.
