



## TOWN OF DAYTON RECYCLING PROGRAM

The Town of Dayton provides curbside collection of recyclables for Town residents and small businesses. Recyclables are collected on Wednesdays of each week. Recycling bins are furnished by the Town's recycling contractor, and may be obtained by calling the Dayton Public Works Department at (540) 879-2241. If you have more recyclables than your bin will contain, you may request an additional bin at no extra cost—please do not put recyclables in plastic bags, as this causes difficulties at the recycling disposal centers). Recycling bins must remain with the property in the event you move to avoid being charged for replacement costs.

The following items are acceptable for recycling collection:

- Plastic containers - all recycling codes accepted (discard lids & rinse). No plastic bags, plastic wrap or Styrofoam accepted.
- Aluminum beverage cans & pie pans
- Glass bottles & jars (clear, green & brown), non-shattering glass only—no windows, mirrors, picture frame glass, etc.
- Tin cans
- Paper, newspaper, magazine & phone books (no hardback books) - no need to separate (if bagging, please use paper bags only, with one exception being for shredded paper, which must be contained in a clear trash bag and placed inside the bin).
- Cardboard & paperboard (flatten) - must be no larger than the size of the bin when flattened—no waxed cardboard accepted.

### HEAVY TRASH COLLECTION

The following items are acceptable for heavy trash collection on the first Tuesday of each month (these items are picked up by Dayton Public Works):

- Appliances
- Furniture
- Electronics
- Bicycles
- Small lawn mowers (remove gas & oil)
