PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES

January 16, 2014

PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS PRESENT: Gerald Lehman, Becky Eberly, Gary Bowman, Charles Long and Jerry Critcher.

PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS ABSENT:

ALSO PRESENT: John Crim and several residents.

CALL TO ORDER: Chairperson Lehman called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

MINUTES: Chairperson Lehman asked for comments on the December 19, 2013 minutes. Hearing none, a motion by Jerry Critcher to approve minutes as written was seconded by Gary Bowman and passed unanimously.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Chairperson Lehman asked for comments and findings on the use of golf carts. He stated that the Code of Virginia would be a good place to start. Jerry Critcher talked with the Town of Elkton. He handed out a packet of information containing a list of ordinances. The ordinance covers roads, speed limits, inspection, licenses, etc. There were a few other contacts made. Chairperson Lehman stated that they would take all the information and digest it and discuss it more at the next meeting.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION: Kevin McDermott

Mr. McDermott from the HRMPO arrived and gave a brief overview of a letter dated 12/9/13 from the CTB Fall Transportation Meeting. The letter contained a list of prioritized projects that the HRMPO would like to work with VDOT to advance.

One of the projects included the Route 42/712 Connector. The Planning Commission expressed concerns as to why this made the list. Mr. McDermott answered questions and said that he would pass along the thoughts of the Planning Commission. Charles Long stated that there was concern for the Intersection of Silver Lake, Eberly, and College Streets.

NEW BUSINESS:

Becky Eberly read a letter from a resident concerning nearby property.

With there being no further business to come before the Planning Commission, a motion by Gary Bowman to adjourn was seconded by Becky Eberly and passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:13 PM.
