PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES

April 17, 2014

PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS PRESENT: Gerald Lehman, Becky Eberly, Gary Bowman, Charles Long and Jerry Critcher.

CALL TO ORDER: Chairperson Lehman called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM.

MINUTES: Chairperson Lehman asked for comments on the February 20, 2014 minutes as there was not a meeting in March. Hearing none, a motion by Gary Bowman to approve minutes as written was seconded by Jerry Critcher and passed unanimously. (one abstention: Charles Long)

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Golf Carts – Mayor Long updated on the status. A questionnaire has been set up on the website and paper copies are also available for resident feedback. So far there are only 7 responses for golf cart use and 1 against. That is not enough response to make a decision. Encourage residents to respond through the end of April. Could extend through May. After discussing, Chairperson Lehman asked members to talk with their neighbors about completing the survey. The PC will evaluate again next month.

Chairperson Lehman asked about the Redbud Festival. Mayor Long briefed on the vendors, Veterans driving golf carts and received donations, Augusta pet adoptions, and music.

Jerry Critcher talked about Strites Donuts and the new business at the corner of 257 and 42.

Mayor Long updated on Artisans Courtyard. Hopefully have more information by the next meeting.

There was general discussion on the protocol of public hearing on special use permits.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Long announced that Chief Conley resigned. There was a brief discussion on the hiring process.

Chairperson Lehman stated that his term ends June 30th. After five years of service he will be stepping out. Will put something in writing.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:26 PM.
